I want to thank those of you who have renewed your Membership in the Friends of the Library. Please help us encourage new memberships. Your support is very important.

Some of you may wonder, what does your membership mean to the library? Here are some of the ways your commitment makes a difference:

- As the saying goes, there is strength in numbers. As many of you know we are actively advocating for a new library in San Carlos. As we approach potential donors and the city council, it is important that we can demonstrate the community interest and need for the new building.

There are limited city/public funds available to upgrade the libraries, so the Friends have taken on this responsibility. - This year, due to a generous donation, we are upgrading our Children's Area to make it more user friendly for our young patrons.
- Your dues support the very important youth activities, such as the Essay Contest and the Summer Reading Program. These programs are so important to help teach our youth the value of the library and how it can help improve their educational experience.

On January 9, 2014, the San Carlos Library will celebrate its 40th Anniversary. This year, in recognition of this occasion, SCFOL is planning several events to highlight the important value the San Carlos Library has had to our community.
